

To start: February 8th
Location: O'Connell Street median
Duration: 5 days approximately



Metro North ground investigations are due to start on February 8th on the median of O'Connell Street, between Prince's Street North and the Gray Statue. Bore holes will be dug, using similar drilling machines to what is shown, and the works will be surrounded by hoardings to protect the public. The pavement will be fully reinstated upon completion of the works. The ground investigation is required to examine the condition of the soil, the underlying groundwater and the geological conditions of the area before the main works begin on Metro North.
